Introduction

The book in your hands is part of a twelve-book series named "Sirāt," produced by the Jaffari Islamic Study Board (JISB) comprised of the three Islamic Shia Study Centres (ISSC): Al-Haadi Study Centre, Al-Muntadhir Study Centre and Al-QaAim Study Centre. The books are part of the Religious Education (Diniyāt) program of the Study Centres.

Each book consists of a total of twenty eight lessons, seven each on Islamic Beliefs (Aqāid), Islamic Laws (Fiqh), Islamic History (Tārikh), and Islamic Ethics (Akhlāq). The first seven textbooks are also supplemented by Workbooks consisting of activities and worksheets. In addition, the Sirāt Textbooks and Workbooks are accompanied by a Teacher's DVD. The DVD contains media intended to serve as a teaching aid. Some of the lessons in the textbooks refer to the media contained in the DVD.

Each Sirāt Textbook has the syllabus and objectives for the respective grades outlined at the outset. Some topics are prefixed with an asterisk in the syllabus as they are highly recommended for students to demonstrate proficiency in before the end of the Madrasah year. Teachers are advised to use the objectives and recommendations to guide them in lesson planning.

The JISB is, Inshā Allāh, committed to continually refining the Sirāt Textbooks and related resources in collaboration with 'ulema, educators, teachers and administrators. If you have any suggestions for changes or improvement, please contact us as we value your feedback, which goes through a strict approval process before it is implemented. This is to ensure that the content and quality of the Sirāt Textbooks or Workbooks are not compromised in any way. Every Sirāt Textbook or Workbook will have the "Revised and Printed" date on this Introduction page. This is to ensure that you have the latest edition in your hands. Takbirat al-Ihrām, Qiyām, Qunūt, Rukū, Sajdah, Julus













Prophet Muhammad (s) said:


My family, the Ahl al-Bayt, is like the Ark of Nabi Nuh. Whoever joins it will be safe. And whoever refuses to go with it, will drown.



If you hold on tight to the Ahl al-Bayt ('a) and stay with them, you will always be safe.


Nabi Nuh (a) and his Ark






